



SportMaster Acrylic Patch Binder – 1 Gallon Batch

Materials Needed:

- **V** 1 gallon SportMaster Acrylic Patch Binder
- 30 lbs clean silica sand (50–60 mesh) (Approx. 2 dry gallons or 26.74 lbs based on 13.37 lbs/gal)
- 6 lbs Portland or Hydraulic Cement (Approx. ½ gallon dry volume)

Mixing Procedure:

1. Dry Blend First:

In a clean mixing container, combine:

- 30 lbs Sand
- 6 lbs Cement
- → Mix thoroughly until uniform.
- Recommended: Screen cement to remove potential clumps before mixing.

2. Add Binder:

- Slowly pour **1 gallon** of Acrylic Patch Binder into the dry mix.
- Stir constantly while adding to prevent clumping.

3. Mix to Slurry:

- Continue mixing until a smooth, workable slurry is formed.
- Adjust consistency as needed using small amounts of binder or sand.

Notes:

- Use clean tools and containers.
- Mix only what can be applied within 30–60 minutes.
- Avoid adding water.
- Screening cement helps improve mix quality and prevent uneven texture.
