## PickleMaster System 5 Gal Pail Mixing

MIXING DEVICE: 1 or $1.5 \mathrm{hp} 3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ drill with 55 gallon Mud mixer-type drill with paddle attachment

## PickleMaster

ColorPlus Pigment Dispersion Water

5 gallon pail
3 pints (6 cups)
2 gallons

1. Start with 1 full 5 -gallon pail of PickleMaster \& 1 clean empty container with room to hold approx. 10 gallons worth of liquid volume. If mixing multiple pails of PickleMaster, use the same mixing ratios per 5-gal of PickleMaster and box the final mixes together for best results.
2. Pour PickleMaster into larger empty container.
3. Add correct amount of ColorPlus pigment dispersion to PickleMaster.
4. Measure water for dilution and pour into the PickleMaster \& Pigment.
5. Blend with drill and paddle mixer until a consistent mix is achieved.
6. Make sure to re-mix right before application to prevent separation \& ensure proper suspension of sand. Note: Make sure not to exceed dilution rate. For best results, avoid application during extremely hot temperatures.
